In the future, Sauter Feinmechanik GmbH will again produce and offer its services exclusively under the "Made in Germany" label: The joint venture in Asia for the production of tool turrets has ended, and the assembly factory in Hungary has been closed. The company is thus once again concentrating all activities at its headquarters in Metzingen. All activities including design, sales, customer service, repair, and spare parts are focused there. Only in North America is a service unit still active. The company's reorganization will thus be completed after Sauter's acquisition by the Berlin-based Zeitfracht Group in 2021.

Sauter continues to be very successful and particularly strong in the after-sales business with repairs and spare parts. A team of experienced technicians provides worldwide service for Sauter products. The team at Sauter North America, based near Detroit, is also focusing more on the service sector.

In line with the new orientation, Sauter invests in training and the promoting young talent for qualified, skilled workers in Metzingen – with apprenticeships for precision mechanics and technical product designers. The company is also active in university training programs such as the Bachelor of Engineering in the "Reutlingen Model."
